- She was given her nickname by friends when Mikayla ordered coffee on a very hot day, and everyone else ordered cold sodas
- She started writing lyrics as a teenager – a line or two, then a chorus or verse
- She composed all of the songs she is performing today
- Lyrics of her songs focus on faith, resilience, and gratitude
