Dr. Juan Tony Guzmán Conductor



Juan Tony Guzmán A conductor, composer, arranger, and music educator from the Dominican Republic, professor Juan Tony Guzmán is director of the Luther College Jazz Orchestra and Jazz Program, and holds the Weston Noble Endowed Chair in Music.

Guzmán is a sought-after conductor of all-state and honor choirs, concert bands, jazz bands, and symphony orchestras across the United States. He frequently serves as a guest conductor, clinician, and adjudicator at festivals

across North America, Central and South America, Europe, Asia, and the Middle East. Guzmán has recently done clinics and presentations for the Singapore American School, The Choral Music Experience, Association for Music in International Schools, Universidade Federal da Paraíba and the Universidade Federal do Rio Grande do Norte in Brazil, World Choral Symposium, the Scottish Association for Music Education, and the Festival 500 in Canada.

An active arranger, Guzmán is known for his choral arrangements of Caribbean and Latin American music, some of which are published by Boosey & Hawkes and Oxford University Press.

Guzmán holds a Ph.D. in music education, a certificate in pedagogy of music theory, and a master's degree in music education from Florida State University. He has a bachelor of arts in music education from Luther College and a degree in electromechanical engineering from the Universidad Católica Madre y Maestra in Santiago, Dominican Republic.



Dr. Corey Pompey Conductor



In the spring of 2019, **Dr. Corey Pompey** was appointed associate director of bands at UW-Madison, succeeding longtime director Mike Leckrone.

Most recently, Dr. Pompey was assistant professor of music, associate director of bands/director of athletic bands at the University of Nevada-Reno. Prior, he served as the assistant director of bands at Pennsylvania State University, where he assisted with the Penn State Marching Blue Band and Athletic Bands, conducted the

Concert Band, taught undergraduate conducting, and assisted with student teacher supervision.

Dr. Pompey also served as an assistant instructor with University Bands at The University of Texas at Austin. He was involved in all creative and administrative aspects of the program, some of which include The University of Texas Wind Ensemble and The Longhorn Band. Dr. Pompey taught in the public schools of Alabama for seven years prior to moving to Texas.

Dr. Pompey holds the bachelor of science degree in music education and the master of arts degree in music education from The University of Alabama. He earned his doctor of musical arts degree in wind conducting at The University of Texas. Principal conducting teachers include Jerry F. Junkin, Kenneth Ozzello, and Gerald L. Welker.

Professional affiliations include the College Band Directors National Association and Phi Mu Alpha.

Dr. Timothy Mahr Conductor



Dr. Timothy Mahr holds a B.M. degree in composition and a B.A. degree in music education from St. Olaf College and a master's degree in trombone performance and a D.M.A. in instrumental conducting from the University of Iowa.

An internationally acclaimed composer, Dr. Mahr received the 1991 Ostwald Award in the ABA Band Composition Contest for his composition The Soaring Hawk. He was elected to the American Bandmasters

Association in 1993. Formerly director of bands at the University of Minnesota-Duluth and founding conductor of the Twin Ports Wind Ensemble, Dr. Mahr is the principal conductor of the Minnesota Symphonic Winds and is active as a clinician and guest conductor nationally and internationally. Recent commissions have come from the United States Air Force Band, the Music Educators National Conference, and the American Bandmasters Association. Twenty-five of his works have been published, with many released on compact disc recordings and included on state contest lists.

Dr. Mahr is a past-president of the North Central Division of the College Band Directors National Association (1999-2001), has served on the Board of Directors of the National Band Association (1996-98) and was a founding board member of the Minnesota Band Directors Association.



VISION





Every town Melanie traveled became her teacher and an opportunity to hone her craft as a songwriter, troubadour, and an emissary of tolerance, kindness, and harmony through the sound of her golden voice.

HERE'S THE DEAL: She's traveled the world, was a founding member of the Grammy nominated vocal ensemble Linda Tillery and the Cultural Heritage Choir, and is constantly amazed by her life. But nothing is closer to her heart than bringing people together wherever she is to experience the healing power of music. 

Dr. Jilek completed his doctoral studies in Choral Conducting at the University of North Texas with a





Jean R. Perrault Conductor



Born in Port-au-Prince, Haiti, Jean (Rudy) Perrault is a sought-after educator/clinician, composer, performer, and conductor, nationally and internationally. His compositions have been commissioned for, and performed by, world famous musicians and ensembles. His most recent compositions include a work for string orchestra (Sometimes, I Feel...), commissioned by the Northwest Suburban Conference high school orchestra programs, depicting the events surrounding the George Floyd murder; a Duo for Flute and Double Bass entitled

"Caged" commissioned for the 2020 National Flute Conference; and a Piano Trio (We Three Kings) commissioned by the Clayton-Jackson-McGhie Memorial organization, marking the 100th anniversary of the 1920 Duluth lynching.

Current projects include a Duo for Violin and Cello (Dialogues for Violin and Cello), a Duo for Cello and Hand Drum (Peze Kafe), a work for 13 Instruments, and an arrangement of Ludovic Lamothe's Danza #4 for Violin, Cello and Hand Drum. His latest commission is a Duo for Cello and Piano for the Bardin-Niskala-Duo. Future projects include setting to music three poems of world-renowned author Edwidge Danticat, and a ballet (Seremoni). For more than a decade, Rudy has been collecting, digitizing, and editing the piano works of Haitian classical composers. His latest compilation: "The music of Solon Verret", will soon become available. Rudy's compositions, compilations and arrangements are distributed through JW Pepper.

He is Professor of Music and Director of Orchestras, at the University of Minnesota Duluth. He is a frequent judge/panelist at festivals and competitions in all corners of the world. Rudy is a founding member of the Kako Foundation (kakofoundation.com), a non-profit organization dedicated to bringing music to at-risk youth in the US and Haiti. Rudy makes his home in Duluth, Minnesota.

The 2022-2023 All-State bands, choirs, orchestra, and jazz band were selected through auditions in spring of 2022. Judges listened to the students evaluating them on their overall musicianship and technique. Final rosters were chosen, selecting 585 young musicians for the seven All-State ensembles.

Each All-State camp began on Tuesday, August 2, when students met their guest conductor and section coaches for the first time. Placement auditions for seating were followed by long hours of rehearsals and sectionals. Although the major focus during the summer camp was making music, a full schedule of recreation and social activities gave students opportunities to develop new friendships. The August concerts are the result of dedication by some of the most talented young musicians in Minnesota. All members will also meet to perform as part of the MMEA Midwinter Convention in February 2023.

All-State History:

The first All-State concert was held on October 27, 1944 when guest conductor Robert Shaw directed the 1000-voice choir accompanied by 125 students in the orchestra at the annual meeting of the Minnesota Education Association in the St. Paul Auditorium. Seventy-one schools sent students to this event. The first All-State band was organized two years later when they performed with the choir on October 24, 1946. Harold Bachman was the first conductor of the All-State band, and radio state KUOM made a recording of the concert to distribute to Minnesota radio stations wishing to broadcast the program as a public service.

MMEA performing groups continued to assemble during even-numbered years to perform at the Fall convention. An All-State choir appeared on each occasion and All-State band and orchestra alternated appearances. The first All-State camp was organized at Bethel College in September 1962, where the orchestra rehearsed in preparation for its appearance at the Minnesota State Fair. In 1964, under the leadership of MMEA President Murrae Freng, the summer camp format was established for the band, choir, and orchestra at Bemidji State College, and each of the All-State groups began performing twice annually. In 1975, all three All-State organizations performed at the same Midwinter Clinic for the first time. A plan to rotate the camps among various college campuses was implemented in July 1976. An All-State jazz ensemble was added in 1982 in cooperation with the Minnesota chapter of the National Association of Jazz Educators. In 1991, men's and women's choirs were added, and in 1999, a second All-State band was added. One of the highlights of All-State has been the participation of nationally known guest conductors. Past conductors include Antal Dorati, John Paynter, Weston Noble, Dale Warland, Henry Sopkin, Paul Christiansen, James Croft, Marvin Rabin, Lucien Cailliet, H. Robert Reynolds, Miles Johnson, Frank Bencriscutto, Fred Sturm, Jim Warrick, Henry Charles Smith, Don Craig, and Douglas McEwen. The members of MMEA hope the experience of working with outstanding conductors and sharing musical gifts will be a cherished memory long after the camps and concerts are concluded.
