Our presentation today is the collective work of 18 months of		
discussion, collaboration, research and development outlining the		
details to include guitar education, modern band, and adaptive		
ensemble in the Minnesota All-State Ensembles. As our state

confronts systemic racism and loss, we feel compelled to act through the medium we know best, music. All of our students in MN whether rural, urban, suburban, black, white, asian, latinx, indigenous, mixed-race, sis gendered, gender fluid, gay, straight, bisexual, neurotypical, and neurdiverse all deserve every opportunity possible to engage in the powerful artform of music. We all know personally the myriad benefits that music brings to the human spirit. Guitar education, modern band and adaptive ensemble adds to our music education palate, offering students not typically found in band, choir, orchestra or jazz into our community of musicians. All music is a benefit to all students and we are seeking to increase our musical body in Minnesota. We are proposing the addition of an All-State Guitar Orchestra, All-State Modern Band and an All-State Adaptive ensemble.

 - Name and Branding, Administrative Access, bringing more students and educators into MMEA
 - Providing access into the all-state program for schools who do not have students able to audition for BCOJ ensembles
- Nomination based ensemble placements instead of Auditioned
- Money
 - Give to the Max day for funding?
- Administrative access: Database of educators and their programs
