Process for obtaining graduate credit from the University of St. Thomas:

1. If you are NEW to St. Thomas' Graduate Music program, complete a [non-degree application](#) by the date of the convention.
If you have taken prior Graduate Music courses at St. Thomas, log into Murphy and register for **MUSW 501-05: Workshop Essays** using the assigned CRN for Spring term (available in Classfinder).
2. Attend **fifteen** (15) session/concert hours during the MMEA Midwinter Convention. These hours can be obtained by attending sessions and concerts during the conference.

AND

Write a brief description of each session or critical review of concerts. Include:

Sessions

- Title, presenter's name, date & time of session
- Identify the salient points presented.
- Discuss how the topic & presentation may/may not inform or impact your teaching.

Concerts

- Name of group, conductor, and pieces performed.
- Write a critical review.
 - Papers must be double-spaced and typed. Allow for one page per workshop, session, or concert.
- Include a cover page with the following information (ALL items are required):
 - Date
 - Name
 - Phone
 - Email address
 - Mailing address
 - Date of Birth
 - Social Security number **OR** your St. Thomas identification number (*one of these is required*)

3. Send your paper, cover page, and fee to the address listed below OR email your essay to music@stthomas.edu and mail the fee to the address listed below. Please write your **last name** and **MUSW 501** on the reference line of your check.

**** Papers must be postmarked no later than MARCH 1 of the conference year. ****
